- Please use 12pt Times Roman, double spaced with 2.5cm margins.
- Each entry must be emailed to nbrfshortstory@gmail.com by 11.59pm AEST on 30 June 2024. Entries received after this time will be ineligible. Stories should be emailed as Word documents (.doc/.docx format) and be accompanied by this entry form.
- Entries will be judged anonymously. Please DO NOT include your name anywhere on the manuscript. Only the title of your story should appear on the manuscript.
- Entries will be independently judged. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- NBRF committee members, their immediate family members and the judging panel are not eligible to enter the competition.
- Winner, second and third place entries will be announced during the Festival weekend between 27-29
 September 2024.
- First prize: \$500 + certificate; Second Prize: Book voucher to the value of \$100 + certificate; Third Prize: Book voucher to the value of \$50 + certificate.
